Prices drop in China's domestic market

A small volume of tonnes traded domestically in China on Friday at lower price levels, weighing on prices in the region. Import prices were flat day on day amid no new business concluded.

In the domestic market, 1,000t traded at Yn930/t ex-works from river port stock, concluded between traders. Domestic prices were assessed in line with this trade.


China's port inventory rose to 2.72mn t today.

China cfr prices were flat day on day on no fresh business concluded.


