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MARKET COMMENTARY

Sakhalin coal production grows

Russian mining companies based in Sakhalin Island in Russia's far east increased thermal coal production by 1.6mn t to 16.9mn t in 2024, market participants' data show. But export shipments via local pots were almost flat and deliveries to China, the largest buyer of local material, dropped.

Sakhalin-based mining firms produce thermal coal with around 90pc of total output exported via local ports. In 2024, Sakhalin's ports handled around 15mn t of coal, almost unchanged year on year, market participants' data show, with fewer shipments to China, but more vessels being sent to South Korea and Taiwan, according to data from analytics firm Kpler.

East Mining, the largest coal producer in the region, led the coal production increase, while a few other mining firms reduced output last year. East Mining lifted coal production at its Solntsevsky opencast by almost 2mn t to 15.2mn t in 2024. The company produces thermal coal with a calorific value (CV) of NAR 3,800-4,900 kcal/kg at Solntsevsky opencast. The firm exports almost all its output during the navigation period and mainly builds its stocks in winter during the ice season.

The Port of Shakhtersk, the largest in the region, owned by East Mining, shipped around 13.7mn t of coal in 2024, up by 520,000t on the year, market participants' data show. According to Kpler data, shipments from the port to China decreased by 1.7mn t on the year, to 10.5mn t in 2024. Meanwhile, dispatches from the port to South Korea jumped to 1.9mn t against only 513,000t the previous year. Shakhtersk increased shipments to Japan to 217,000t against 73,000t a year earlier. Also, there were around 330,000t of coal shipped to Taiwan, while in 2023 no such dispatches were registered via Shakhtersk, according to Kpler. The port can load Capesize vessels at anchorage. It freezes in winter and can only handle coal during the navigation period, which usually opens in March-April and ends in December.

Shipments from another Sakhalin-based port, Nevelsk, decreased by 320,000t to 1.1mn t last year, with China receiving almost all the volumes. Exports through Aleksandrovsk-Sakhalinsky port fell by more than two-thirds to 174,000t.

Last year, Gornyak 1, the second-largest coal mining firm in Sakhalin, cut production by 117,000t on the year





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to 1.6mn t because of lower results in September-October 2024. Another Sakhalin-based coal producer Boshnyakovsky opencast mined around 102,000t last year against 446,000t in the previous year. Since April this company suspended coal production owing to complicated mining, geological and technological conditions, according to market sources.


Coal mining firms face tighter railcar availability

The daily fee for railcars used to transport coal in Russia increased in February owing to tighter availability of railcars, as Russian state-owned railway operator RZD has recently removed many idle railcars from its network.


The fee for open-top railcars rose by 100 roubles/d (\$1.01/d) from January to Rbs2,710-2,820/d (\$27.50-28.62/d) in February, excluding 20pc value-added tax (VAT), operators and coal suppliers said.

RZD continues to optimise its railcar fleet, removing around 105,000 railcars of all types from the railway network by early January, market participants said. This may have limited the supply of railcars available to coal mining firms, but train speeds and railcar turnover have accelerated as there is now more free space on rail lines, market participants said.

Higher railcar turnover has lowered the cost of coal transport, which depends on the time taken for coal to be delivered to the destination point. The cost of delivering coal from Kuzbass to the Baltic port of Ust-Luga decreased by Rbs750/railcar to Rbs124,000-129,000/railcar in February. The cost of transporting coal to the far east port of Vostochny fell by Rbs2,000/railcar to Rbs156,000-163,000/railcar.

But the cost of delivering coal from Kuzbass to Taman rose by Rbs1,500/railcar to Rbs131,500-136,500/railcar, market participants said. Coal mining firms have increased their export shipments through Taman after RZD increased its allowance for railcar movements along the route.

The cost delivering coal from Kazakhstan's large coal mining region of Karaganda to the Russian port of Ust-Luga for export decreased by Rbs4,250/railcar to around Rbs136,000-139,500/railcar in February, while the cost for transport along the route from Karaganda to Taman fell by Rbs4,000/railcar Rbs138,500-142,000/railcar.

Price for standard railcar leases falls

The average lease rate for 69t open-top railcars in shortterm agreements fell by Rbs240/d on the month to Rbs2,250-2,340/d, excluding VAT, in February. Lease rates for 69t railcars in one-year agreements inched up by Rbs5/d to Rbs2,310-2,470/d, excluding VAT.

Demand for standard open-top railcars is falling because of reduced coal transport at export routes. The near-term outlook for overall bulk cargo deliveries in Russia is bearish. Overall coal deliveries in Russia decreased by 400,000t on the month to 29.7mn t in January, according to RZD, because of falling shipments to northwestern ports to domestic consumers. Deliveries of construction materials, steel and iron ore also fell in January.

But demand for railcars with higher capacity is rising, after RZD and the Kuzbass authorities agreed to use highercapacity railcars for export coal deliveries to far eastern ports from April.

As a result, rates for 75t railcars in short-term contracts increased by Rbs110/d to Rbs3,090-3,210/d, excluding VAT, in February. Rates for long-term leases of 75t railcars rose by Rbs75/d to Rbs3,000-3,130/d, excluding VAT, according to market participants.

Raspadskaya suspended production at Alardinskaya mine

Russian coking coal producer Raspadskaya, which is based in Kuzbass, suspended operations at its Alardinskaya mine after a fire at the beginning of December.

Local authorities said an earthquake might have caused the fire. Repairs are under way and may take some time, although the mine aims to resume production this year, market participants said. Raspadskaya declined to comment on the accident.

Alardinskaya, accounted for 9pc of Raspadskaya output last year, and production from the site rose by 400,000t to 1.6mn t, according to data from market participants. But December output fell to 88,000t from 160,000t in November and 207,000t in December 2023.

Alardinskaya can produce 3mn t of low and mid-volatile semisoft KS-grade coking coal, which can also be used as pulverised coal injection (PCI). Its reserves are estimated at over 420mn t, according to Raspadskaya.

Alardinskaya mostly supplies local steel mills, with some volumes also shipped to Raspadskaya's washing facility.

Raspadskaya's overall coal production — in the Kuzbass and at its asset in the Tyva region — fell by 360,000t to 18.5mn t last year, market participants' data show. The firm cut domestic shipments by 1.1mn to 10.9mn t, while its exports fell by 570,000t to 7.1mn t, of which 6.9mn t shipped from Kuzbass, rail data show.

Raspadskaya's coking coal output could fall again this year, tracking the downtrend in Russia's steel sector. The suspension at Alardinskaya mine fits this scenario, market participants said.

Chinese demand for met coal still absent

Russian pulverised coal injection (PCI) prices decreased slightly last week, dampened by continuing weak demand from Chinese buyers, who have recently returned from the lunar new year holidays with no intention of active buying.

The Argus-assessed Russian low-volatile PCI price fell by $25 \notin /t$ on the week to 120.00/t fob Vostochny on 5 February, with the market remaining quiet in the region.

No deals were concluded at the start of February, indicating a lack of Chinese buyers returning to the market after the holiday. Furthermore, there were no signs of recovery in China's steel and coke sector, and metallurgical coal stocks remain high.

Demand in India was weak, with local buyers seeking significant price discounts. The offered price for large cargoes of Russian mid-volatile PCI was at around \$138/t cfr India last week, while Indian buyers bids were around \$131/t cfr, according to market participants. At the start of previous week, Russian low-volatile PCI was offered at 130-132/t cfr India.

Russian suppliers currently view only the Vietnamese market as the most active and promising, expecting further growth in the country's construction steel demand. But Russian PCI exporters were not actively making offers to Vietnamese buyers, as the market awaited more price indications from China. According to traders, Vietnamese buyers' bids were at \$131/t cfr for Russian PCI, while offers started at \$138/t cfr last week.

Russian low-volatile PCI was offered to Indonesian buyers at 138/t cfr with no deals registered.

The freight rate for Handysize vessel from Russian far east ports to China was estimated at \$8-12/t last week. At the end of January, freight rate for Panamax vessels stood at \$6.35/t.

Coking coal market muted

Russian coking coal exporters didn't see any interest from Chinese buyers as they started to return from the lunar new year holiday. Some exporters were hopeful for an improvement in Chinese demand, but most sellers did not see a solid basis for this.

The *Argus* weekly assessed price for prime high-volatile coking coal decreased by \$2.00/t on the week to \$118.85/t fob Vostochny on 5 February.

The price for Russian GZh-grade coking coal was estimated at \$125-126/t cfr China. While Russian GZh and Zh-grade coking coal for India was assessed at \$137-140/t cfr. No trades were reported, according to market participants.

Russian mid-CV prices slightly up in Asia-Pacific

Russian mid-calorific value (CV) thermal coal prices inched up in Asia-Pacific markets last week, supported by reviving demand as China returned from a week-long holiday.

Russian NAR 5,500 kcal/kg prices increased by $17 \epsilon/t$ on the week to 76/t fob Vostochny.

A Handysize cargo of Russian NAR 5,500 kcal/kg coal traded at \$90/t cfr for prompt delivery, while Chinese buyers bid for similar cargoes at \$84-85/t cfr last week, traders reported.

"We are trying to book an Australian large cargo of NAR 5,500 kcal/kg coal last week in absence of affordable offers from Russian coal sellers," a Chinese coal trader said.

Mid-CV coal prices may continue to rebound this week, although any notable rise was not likely, market participants said.

Russian NAR 6,000 kcal/kg coal prices in Asia-Pacific fell by 54¢/t on the week to \$91.65/t fob Vostochny.





Russian suppliers offered high-CV cargoes at \$101-103/t cif South Korea, meeting bids below \$100/t cif. Alternative origins, including Australian, were actively offered to South Korea at parity with Russian coal, traders noted.

Last week, one major Russian seller was said to trade a high-CV cargo at \$100-101/t cif to a South Korean state utility, while another Russian exporter sold a cargo at \$99/t cif to an independent utility. Both trades were not confirmed by counterparties.

Meanwhile, Chinese buyers' interest for prompt delivered Russian high and mid-CV coal strengthened at the end of last week owing to restocking after the holiday. Although coal inventories in China remain extremely high amid a mild winter in the country.

Spot freight rates for Panamax vessels moving from Russia's far east to China were estimated at \$6-8/t, and for Handysize vessels on the same route at \$8-10/t, according to coal exporters.

Prices at western ports keep downtrend

Coal prices at Russian western ports fell further last week although trading activity increased, market participants said.

The price of high-CV coal shipped from Baltic Sea ports fell by \$1.13/t to \$71.30/t fob last week.

In Russia's south, prices for large cargoes of high-CV coal fell by $40 \notin t$ on the week to around \$77.60/t fob Taman.


One Panamax cargo of Russian NAR 6,000 kcal/kg coal traded at \$87-88/t cif Turkey, while another same size cargo was sold at \$85-86/t cif Turkey, according to coal traders.

Turkish coal buyers were bidding for Russian NAR 6,000 kcal/kg coal below \$85/t cif, although Russian sellers aimed to keep prices at \$88-89/t. Coal traders noted higher demand for 20,000-30,000t cargoes, as some Turkish buyers were not ready to buy large tonnage cargoes, expecting limited coal demand in coming weeks.

Meanwhile, freight rates for Panamax vessels from the port of Ust-Luga to Iskenderun decreased to \$14-15/t last week, from \$15-16/t previous week, which may support Russian coal prices on fob basis. The freight rate for Panamax vessels from the southern port of Taman to Iskenderun was estimated at \$8-9/t, according to market participants.

The price of Russian high-CV coal shipped from Black Sea ports fell by $83 \notin t$ on the week to around 80.67/t.

A 5,000t cargo of high-CV coal was offered at \$97-99/t cif Turkey last week with freight around \$17/t from one of Russia's Black Sea ports, according to a coal trader. Another small cargo of Russian high-CV coal was offered at around \$100/t cif Turkey for prompt delivery, another trader said.


