COMMENTARY

Americas

US Gulf coast methanol spot prices were steady Thursday. No trades emerged amid limited bid/ask activity in the open spot market. Offers were reported at 109¢/USG. The assessment was based on the last trade, completed on Wednesday, at 105¢/USG fob ITC.

April methanol was also unchanged. No bids or offers were reported, and no trades emerged for April. The April assessment stood at parity to March.

Europe

In the European market, spot barge liquidity was high on Thursday, with prices firming from the previous day's trade. Spot deals for methanol barges basis fob Rotterdam were heard concluded in the range of \leq 344-346/t today, with several transactions heard.

Asia-Pacific

Expectations of increased import supplies kept buyers in China sidelined, while a drop in upstream coal values further eroded buy-side confidence levels. Methanol futures fell by close to 1pc to settle at 2,610 yuan/t.

Prompt cargoes were traded at Yn2,675-2,715/t ex-tank Taicang, lower by Yn5-35/t. Forward delivery cargoes were traded at Yn5-10/t discounts to that of prompt, equivalent to \$318-323/t on an import parity basis. Selling indications for



Middle East origin cargoes arriving in March were at \$325/t cfr China basis, but buying interest stayed muted.

In India, a deal for a 10,000-15,000t, non-sanctioned, Middle East origin cargo was done late yesterday at \$310/t on a cfr West Coast India basis. Meanwhile, local prices have been on a steady rise throughout the week, with cargoes trading at 28-28.5 rupees/kg ex-tank basis.
